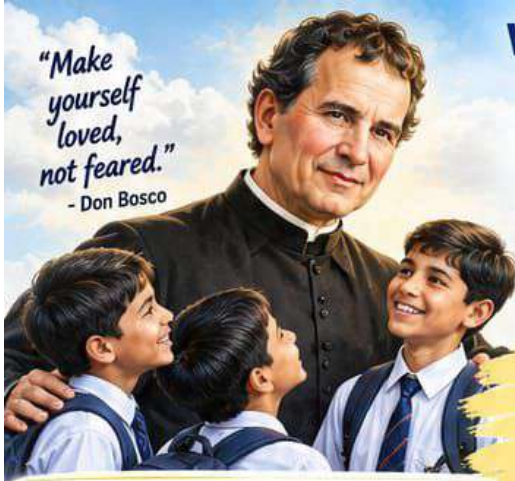

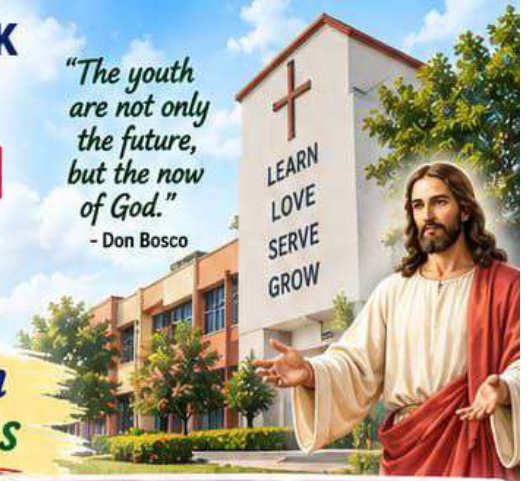

We are sons and daughters of God.

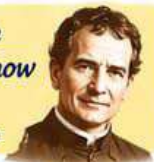
- God sees us.
