

Morning Assembly Talk

Theme: You Are the Choices You Make

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My dear students and teachers, good morning!

We have no choice about when we are born. We have very little choice about when our earthly life ends. But between birth and death, God has given us the wonderful gift of choosing how we live.

Every choice you make becomes a step towards your future.

Choose honesty over cheating.

Choose hard work over laziness.

Choose discipline over excuses.

Choose kindness over anger.

Choose prayer over indifference.

Choose respect over disrespect.

Choose learning over wasting time.

When you make the right choices, you build a life filled with confidence, success, good health, strong character, and holiness. When you make poor choices, you eventually pay the price through sadness, failure, and lost opportunities.

Remember this simple message:

Your life is not determined by chance; it is determined by your choices.

Every great person became great because they repeatedly made the right choices. Every successful student is simply someone who chooses to do the right thing consistently.

So, my dear children, make the right choice at the right time. Never allow peer pressure, laziness, or temporary pleasure to steal your bright future. You have the power to shape your own destiny through the choices you make every single day.

Always remember:

You are the choices that you make.

May each one of you choose what is true, what is good, what is beautiful, and what is pleasing to God.
